- 3. Inova access your tenant to provide services.





Setting Up PAL—Step by Step

1. Login to the Azure portal and click on the Settings icon, as shown below:



2. When the Settings blade is shown, click on "Link your Partner ID to this Azure Account" at the bottom.



3. In the "Microsoft Partner ID" field, enter Inova's MPN ID (see table below) and click on "Link a Partner ID".

- 1. Let your account manager know when you've added PAL. They can ensure everything is set up correctly.
- 2. Setting up PAL requires an Azure user with a contributor or higher access role.
- 3. To maximize your PAL benefits, ensure you add PAL using your subscription or management group owner.
